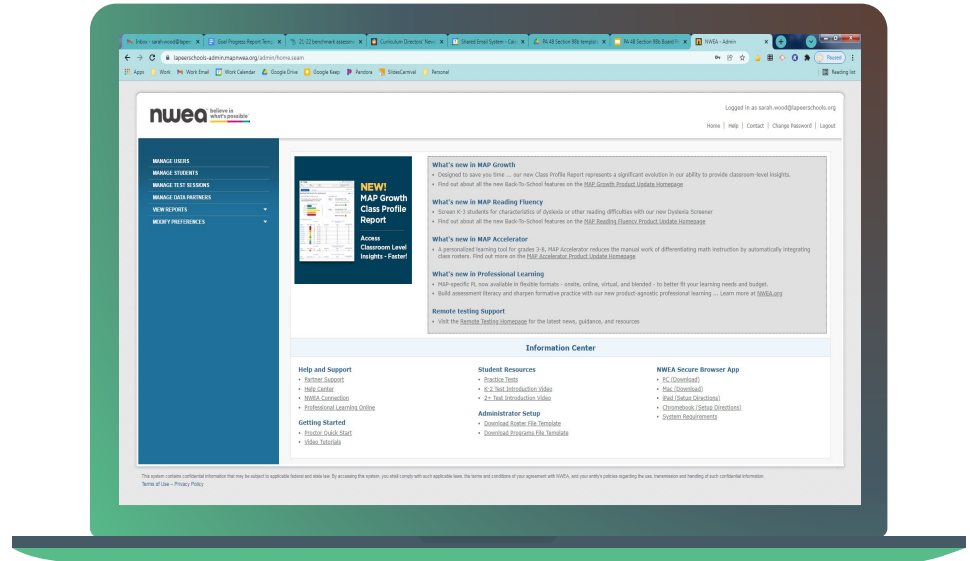

What is PA48, Sec 98b?

Public Act (P.A.) 48 Section 104a requires districts to **implement a benchmark assessment system** for the 2022-2023 school year for the purpose of measuring student proficiency in reading and mathematics.

In addition, P.A. 48 Sec. 98b requires districts to choose a benchmark assessment or assessments that are aligned to state standards and are administered to **determine whether students are making meaningful progress towards mastery of these standards**. Districts must **present the results** from the benchmark assessments administered under section 104a **to local boards**.

Next Steps

- **Data Analysis Days are occurring at all grade levels, district-wide in both ELA and Math to analyze data from NWEA scores, common assessments, and state assessments.**
- **Interventions continue to be implemented in K-5 classrooms, as well as in intervention classes at the secondary level (Guided Academics) and during I-Connect.**
- **Tutoring opportunities after school at the secondary level.**
- **After school credit recovery began, we have added a second teacher.**
- **Professional Development for new teachers at the elementary level.**
- **Interventionists have been added to several buildings.**
- **Dropout Prevention added to RW 2nd semester.**
